



RAIN POLICY

- Only the official Referee can deem a field unplayable due to the standing water or lightening.
- If a field is deemed unplayable by the Referee, then the game may be moved to the indoor turf field IF it is available. This applies for SAS, SYS or PSL league games ONLY.
- If both outdoor fields are unplayable, the games scheduled on Kinsmen Field will have priority to be moved indoors IF field is available. PSL out-of-town teams have priority.
- When weather-related issues arise while two-full field adult games are being played outside, both games may be moved inside and be played half field IF the following criteria is met:
 - Fields are available
 - Participating teams agree
 - Field time from the original game start time is not exceeded
 - Games must reach the required 2/3 (60min) completed time.

The indoor turf rules apply (cards, substitutions, ball going out, etc.) except the length of game will be outdoor rules at 45min halves. However, again games may be reduced in time to no less than 2/3 original outdoor game length and agreement from all participating teams is required prior to the restart of the game.

Also, if 2 half field games are being played outside, they can be moved inside prior to the full field game.
